Kindergarten Packets

Description: We will be assembling packets to all children who will be starting Kindergarten in the Fall of 2023. Little Free Library® Book-Sharing Boxes

Description: Smart Start of Brunswick County, through special grants, community volunteers, and collaborative partnerships, helps to maintain these book-sharing boxes which are open seven days a week and are freely accessible to all - removing barriers to book access. We need help labeling children's books and replenishing the supply in several of the *Little Free Library* locations throughout the county.

Tentative Timeframe: On-going

High Five Recognition

Description: Child care is essential! Without it, parents cannot work, businesses cannot continue to operate, and children cannot access invaluable early learning opportunities. Smart Start of Brunswick County would like to thank and give a "High Five" to our Early Childhood Professionals who care for and educate children in the fabulous, first five years of life. BLOCK Fest®

Description: BLOCK Fest is a family interactive experience that uses five stations to introduce children and parents to the educational value of block play. We would also like to plan additional events (such as STEM) that help educate the community about the importance of the first five years in a child's life.

Description: Kaleidoscope Play & Learn, one of our Smart Start funded programs, provides weekly gatherings of parents and young children that offer activities to promote development through play and adult social support.
