SMART START COMMUNITY COLLABORATIVES

Smart Start works to ADVOCATE, EDUCATE, and COLLABORATE here in Brunswick County. Because we know that it takes a village to raise a child – having a system, a community, that communicates and collaborates is vital. Below is a list of groups that staff is a part of and meets regularly with:

Brunswick Wellness Coalition

The coalition is made up of about 48 organizations/businesses that work together to improve the health of our community with the vision of becoming the healthiest county in NC. This is done through collaborative events and community education.

Every Student Succeeds Act Transition Plan Committee

Made up of several organizations that influence a child and family's transition to Kindergarten.

Child Fatality Prevention Team

Group of professionals meet regularly to review and discuss cases of fatalities in our county among children and teens birth through age 18.

Local Interagency Coordinating Council

Local Interagency Coordinating Councils (LICCs) are community-based advisory groups. Each county should have a LICC. Local service providers and parents work together to make sure that all families know about early intervention services.

Resilient Brunswick

Resilient Brunswick is made up of community members and professionals who are passionate about supporting the well-being of Brunswick County. We are committed to educating and connecting citizens of all ages with the tools and resources needed to overcome past, present, and future adverse experiences.

Safe Kids

Safe Kids works with a network of partners within a tri-county region to reduce traffic injuries, drownings, falls, burns, poisonings and more.

School Readiness Committee

This committee is organized by Head Start and includes agencies that support families through the Kindergarten transition process.
